This is your reminder about the Financial Aid Workshop meeting this Wednesday night at 7 pm in the Chapel. Cynthia Martinez, recruiter and financial aid counselor at California State University Northridge will be our guest presenter. She will be reviewing with you how to complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) which is required by all colleges to offer financial aid to your student. You will also be presented with information about the Cal Grant Entitlement program which is the largest source of free money for college funded by the state of California.

To apply for the Cal Grant, the student will need the FAFSA and the Cal Grant GPA forms filed by March 2nd. For information about Cal Grant visit www.csac.ca.gov There are two ways to submit this information – electronically, which is done by Village, or paper application, which is done by the student. If we have your senior's SSN in our school records by January 15, we will automatically send the GPA information electronically for Cal Grant consideration. If we do not have your seniors SSN by this date, you will need to complete and mail the GPA Verification Form. You can get a GPA form by calling (888) 224-7268 or (916) 526-7590 to request it, or by downloading it at <http://www.csac.ca.gov/doc.asp?id=1177>. If you don't want us to electronically send the GPA information for Cal Grant consideration, please call the office and let us know before January 15th.
