We would like to invite you and your students to our third annual **College Prep and Honors/AP Information Meeting**. This meeting will take place at 7:00 PM in the Auditorium on Monday, March 1, 2010.

Advanced Placement classes are college level classes that students can take in high school. If they pass the year-end exam, they could receive college credit for the course. Honors classes are advanced high school courses that prepare students to take AP courses. At this meeting, we will share information about course content and expectations. We will also discuss the skills that colleges expect incoming freshmen to have and how we at Village Christian High School develop those skills in our students.

Honors and Advanced Placement teachers have very high expectations for students and the decision to take these classes should not be made lightly.
