Village Christian School started with the objective of presenting the Gospel to an unreached mission field. Closely related with this main objective was the goal of providing an old fashioned American Education that was Christ-centered.

In 1948, Pastor Phil Gibson started a nursery school at Village Church. The following year saw an elementary school with 36 students.

Fast-forward to 1957 when the Board of Directors approved plans for a K-12 school. There was no funding for buildings, but the “dads” donated labor while the “moms” provided hot lunches.

As the buildings went up and the mountain came down, Village Christian continued to be built by those parents eager to see a difference in their child’s education.

From the beginning tuition was kept within reach of the average family and in doing so provided just enough to cover the operational expenses. Without the dedication of the parents, friends of the church, and school in donating money, materials, and labor, there would be no Village Christian School today.
