1. Diamond Girls

Softball players Emily Siedel and Maddi Velasquez earn regional softball honors. Emily and Maddi were chosen by the National Fastpitch Coaches Association for the All-Region (West) first-team. They earned a spot from a group of players representing seven states: California, Oregon, Washington, Arizona, Nevada, Utah, and New Mexico. These girls were two of only four chosen from southern California.

This is one of many accolades earned by Siedel this season, who has also given her verbal commitment to play for the University of Nevada, Reno in 2011-2012. As the pitcher for the Crusaders, Emily earned CalHi Sports-ESPN Rise All-State Small Schools Team, Division V first-team All-CIF, and All-Olympic League first-team accolades this season. Seidel had a 21-4 record, 321 strikeouts, 40 walks and a 0.47 earned-run average in 164 1/3 innings. In addition, she had 14 shutouts and allowed just 17 runs in 26 appearances.

With Emily Seidel, Maddi Velasquez, and the other returning players the Crusader softball team is hoping to get over the hump and win a Division V CIF title in 2011 after being a semi-finalist for the last two seasons.
