

Sending Test Scores

When available, **send your SAT or ACT** to the colleges you apply to. For multiple CSU and UC campuses, you can save money by sending scores to a single destination: for CSU send to code 3594 (CSUmentor) and then follow directions to send to your campuses. For UC, send to one campus and your scores will be forwarded automatically to the other campuses you apply to. For CSU sending ACT go to this site:

With the **Common Application** You have the option to indicate which school should receive your test scores - just remove your test scores from the section before submitting to a specific institution. You can then add them back to submit to schools that are not test optional. If the test scores are listed they will be provided to the school.

Score Choice allows the test-taker (you) to decide which SAT scores to release to prospective colleges. In the past, colleges would automatically receive all of your scores. Score choice is a free option that you choose when you register for the test. If you do not choose it, your prospective colleges will continue to receive all of your scores
