

## VCS PARENT and STUDENT Guide to COVID

	Condition	What to do	Comments
A	<p>In the past 24 hours student has had one or more of the following symptoms of COVID-19: fever (100.4 degrees F or higher, without fever reducing medications) or feeling feverish (chills/sweating); new cough (change from baseline if chronic allergies or asthma); <b>congestion, runny nose, sore throat</b>, diarrhea or vomiting? Or has your student tested positive for COVID-19 in the last 10 days <b>or are they under isolation orders?</b></p> <p>Or has your student tested positive for COVID-19 in the last 10 days?</p>	<p>Contact your medical provider for further evaluation and possible COVID-19 testing.</p> <p>If doctor confirms <b>alternative diagnosis</b>, symptoms non-COVID, report findings to VCS Health Office. Student must be symptom free for 24 hours before returning.</p> <p>If <b>no doctor consult, not tested, or COVID test is positive</b> <input type="checkbox"/> Do not come to school for at least 10 days from onset of symptoms, AND fever free for 24 hours, and all symptoms have improved. Observe the <a href="#">Isolation Guidance</a> issued by the CDC.</p> <p>If a Covid-19 <b>test is negative</b> Report status to VCS Health Office, student remains at home until 24 hours fever free and improved symptoms.</p>	<p>If tested for COVID, please notify the VCS Health Office of testing results.</p> <p><b>BEFORE returning</b> to school following an absence due to COVID-19 consistent symptoms, parent must contact the VCS Health Office.</p> <p>Call 818-767-8382 x240 or email <a href="mailto:healthofficestaff@villagechristian.org">healthofficestaff@villagechristian.org</a></p>
B	<p>Does your student currently, or within the last 24 hours have ANY other signs of illness or not feeling well?</p>	<p>Do not come to school until ALL symptoms are resolved for a minimum of 24 hours, without any medications.</p> <p>Should any additional symptoms develop, see box A above.</p> <p>Contact your medical provider as needed.</p>	<p>If tested for COVID, please notify the VCS Health Office of testing results.</p>
C	<p>Has your student been in close contact* with anyone at home, school, or elsewhere with confirmed infection of COVID infection in the last 10 days, or are they currently under quarantine orders?</p> <p>*Close contact: A. You were within 6 feet of someone with COVID for a total of 15 minutes or more over a 24-hour period (regardless of masks). B. You had unprotected contact with body fluids and/or secretions from someone with COVID. For example, you were coughed or sneezed on, you shared a drinking cup or eating utensils, you kissed, or provided care to them without the correct protective equipment.</p>	<p>Positive COVID-19 test <input type="checkbox"/> Stay isolated at home until fever free for 24 hours, improved symptoms, and 10 days from symptom onset (or 10 days from test date, if no symptoms). Observe the <a href="#">Isolation Guidance</a> issued by the CDC.</p> <p>Negative COVID-19 test or not tested <input type="checkbox"/> Observe the <a href="#">Quarantine Guidance</a> If remain asymptomatic, quarantine can end after Day 10 from the last date of exposure without testing but they must continue to monitor their health and adhere to COVID-19 prevention precautions through Day 14. Quarantine may end after Day 7 for contacts who remain asymptomatic, if a diagnostic specimen is collected after Day 5 from the date of last exposure and tests negative, but they must continue to monitor their health and adhere to COVID-19 prevention precautions through Day 14.</p> <p><b>If vaccinated, please contact Health Office immediately- may be exempt from quarantine</b></p>	<p>If tested for COVID, please notify the VCS Health Office of testing results.</p> <p>BEFORE returning to school following an exposure to COVID-19, parent must contact the VCS Health Office.</p> <p>Call 818-767-8382 x240 or email <a href="mailto:healthofficestaff@villagechristian.org">healthofficestaff@villagechristian.org</a></p> <p><b>*IF STUDENT IS FULLY VACCINATED, please contact the Health Office for guidance.</b></p>
D	<p>Individual has <b>tested positive</b> for COVID -19, but has no symptoms.</p>	<p>Stay isolated at home until fever free for 24 hours, improved symptoms, and 10 days from symptom onset (or <b>10 days from test date, if no symptoms</b>). Observe the <a href="#">Isolation Guidance</a> issued by the LADPH. If symptoms develop, follow guidance of Box A above.</p>	<p>Please notify the VCS Health Office of testing results.</p>
E	<p>If one of my children is sick, do I and others in the household also need to stay home?</p>	<p>If the sick child has tested positive for COVID-19 then all members of the same household must stay home and follow quarantine instructions (see Box C)</p>
